### message from Mark Heron

#### Dear Members.



### **Rule of the week**


#### Points of Emphasis – Under 9s & Under 11s

(in relation to the court balance rule and the 'no zone' rule)

1) Players must be <u>encouraged by the coaches and referees</u> to get to the designated court balance areas without compromising the 'flow' of the game.









**Under 11As** 

- Players are not allowed to play a zone defence. The basic definition of a zone is to cover an area, rather than a player. <u>If defensive players are not match up in a man to man</u> <u>situation, it is a violation.</u> (Help defence still allowed)
- 3) Players are allowed to double team and trap, as long as the player who is creating the double team, comes from a 'man to man' defensive position, not a zone position. The main thing to look as it is: "Where has the double team come from?"
- 4) If players are being double teamed, they must be encouraged to pass to the open player. In theory, the court balance rule should allow for players to have the space required to get open.
- 5) The 'mercy rule' is in place for under 11A games. If a team is winning by 15 points or more, all defensive players are required to drop back behind the half court line when the offence has an out of bounds possession in their backcourt.

These rules have been approved by the GABA Rules Committee who believe these 'local rules' will benefit all players in the GABA Junior Domestic Competition, as well as our Representative Teams.



### **Codes of Behaviour**

#### Parents:

- Remember that children participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Encourage children to participate, don't force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Encourage children to always play according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful plays by all participants.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities
- Respect officials decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.





#### Coaches:

- Remember that young people participate for pleasure and winning is only part of the fun.
- Never ridicule or yell at a young player for making a mistake or not coming first.
- Be reasonable in your demands on players time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Operate within the rules and spirit of your sport and teach your players to do the same
- Ensure that the time players spend with you is a positive experience. All young people are deserving of equal attention and opportunities.
- Avoid overplaying the talented players; the just-average need and deserve equal time.
- Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of players.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. Encourage players to do the same.
- Show concern and caution toward sick and injured players. Follow the advice of the physician when determining whether an injured players is ready to recommence training or competition.
- Obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up to date with the latest coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young people.
- Any physical contact with a young person should be appropriate to the situation and necessary for the player's skill development.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person's regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
